The relevant Invitation to Bid (ITB) will be accessible electronically to prospective bidders from 17th July, 2026. Instructions to Bidders

- Suppliers/Bidders must be registered and pre-qualified on the Office of Procurement Regulation (OPR) Procurement Depository under the applicable Line of Business by the tender submission deadline. Failure to be pre-qualified by that deadline shall result in the bid being deemed non-responsive and will not be considered further. Suppliers/Bidders are responsible for ensuring that their OPR Procurement Depository profile and all required supporting documentation remain current and valid. Confirmation of pre-qualification does not preclude the TRHA from conducting further due diligence, verification or eligibility assessments at any stage of the procurement proceedings.

- Interested Bidders are required to register via the e-Tender application website at <https://tha.etenderworld.tt/> to access the Invitation to Bid (ITB) Document. Should a Bidder require assistance with accessing or using the e-Tender application, an email enquiry may be submitted to tenders@trha.co.tt. To facilitate a response, the enquiry should include the following information:
 - The Supplier's business name, address, telephone number and alternative email.
 - The name, designation, email address and direct contact number of the Bidder's designated representative for the purpose of the ITB.
- Interested Bidders or their representatives are required to attend the **mandatory site visit**. Registered Bidders will receive the site visit details via the e-Tender platform.
- ITB Document will be issued via the e-tender platform at no cost.
- Tenders (Bids) must be accompanied by the following:
 - Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates or Letter of Exemption issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
 - Valid NIS Certificate of Compliance or Letter of Exemption in accordance with the National Insurance Act.
 - Evidence of current registration and pre-qualification status in the Office of Procurement Regulation (OPR) Procurement Depository.
 - A list of owners of the organization, a copy of the company's Certificate of Incorporation/Business Registration and a Notice of Directors must be submitted with the tender.
 - Companies or Entities sharing Directors, Shareholders, or Ownership structures will not be treated as separate and may be disqualified to prevent potential conflict of interest or collusive bidding. Each submission must represent an independent and bona fide offer. Any evidence of collusion, coordinated pricing, or shared control among bidders will result in immediate disqualification and will be reported to the Office of Procurement Regulation.

Failure to comply with the above will result in tenders being disqualified.
- This tender will be conducted using a **Two-Envelope System**. Bidders must submit their **Technical and Financial Bids** simultaneously as two (2) separate electronic packages via the e-Tender platform.
- This ITB uses a **lot** system. Bidders may submit offers for **one or multiple lots**. The Authority will review all possible combinations of bids and award contracts to those that are responsive and meet the qualification requirements of the published evaluation criteria for the lot(s) submitted.
- The deadline for submission of clarification questions **Monday, 03rd August 2026** via the e-Tender System <https://etenderworld.tt/>
- All bids and supporting documentation shall be submitted in the English Language. Bidders will be evaluated in accordance with the eligibility, qualification and evaluation criteria contained in the Invitation to Bid.
- LATE** bids will **NOT** be accepted or considered under any circumstances. **The e-Tender portal will automatically close at the specified submission deadline.**
- The TRHA reserves the right to cancel the present notice in whole or in part, without reimbursing any cost incurred by any Bidder in submitting their Bids.
